Discuss and consider action on Art Bench options from Noblewins.

BACKGROUND:

LPACC has expressed interest in adding Art Benches to Leander Parks and the Department was recently contacted by a company, Noblewins with options. Noblewins is a company based out of Ohio that specializes in repurposing turbine blades that have been retired from use. Noblewins utilizes the parts to create benches and these options are able to be painted on for additional artistic design. A variety of different styles and options will be shown during the meeting along with estimated pricing.

Noblewins participates in Government co-op purchasing contracts. Prices range from \$5,000-\$10,000. Incentive pricing is currently available until end of May 2025.

- Pilot Program Discount – 5% off for first-time customers
- Primed Discount – 10% off primed products
- Bulk Discount – 15% off when ordering 8 or more products
